

UNDER 8/9 Rules for 2016 7 V 7

- 1. There will be a maximum of 12 players per team including the goalkeepers.
- 2. Games last 45 minutes with two 20 minute halves and a 5 minute interval.
- 3. A size 3 or 4 ball will be used for U8 and size 4 for U9.
- 4. The goals have to be the following sizes: Height = 2 meters Width = 4 meters
- 5. The game will be placed across the width of one half of the field, so that two matches involving 28 players per Under8/9 team can run simultaneously.
- 6. The goal area should be demarcated with a dotted or broken line so as not to interfere with a normal eleven-a-side pitch. Tape or any form of markings may be used as long as it serves the purpose required and is not dangerous in any way to the players.
- 7. There will be no centre spot or halfway line the referee must use his/her Discretion in choosing a kick-off spot. The referee must ensure the opposing team is 10 meters away from the ball at kick-off.
- 8. A penalty awarded within the goal area shall be taken 6m from the goal line.
- 9. Where a free kick is given, the opposing team is to retire 10 meters from the ball.
- 10. A team may make 5 substitutions any time, Any player may be substituted during any period of the game. A player that has been substituted may return to the field anytime after being substituted (Rolling Subs).
- 11. Goal kicks to be taken from the edge of the 10 yard area as normal.(10 yards from the ball).
- 12. The goalkeeper may run with the ball to the edge of the 10 yard area (with no interference) before kicking the ball into play.
- 13. There will be no off-side rule.
- 14. All other general rules of football will apply to the under 8/9, save those listed above.
- 15. Coaches are not allowed on the field of play.
- 16. There will be No postponements for any games however should a team have a school function, tour etc, the game may be brought forward.
- 17. NO CARD NO PLAY
